Program Funding:

- \$2mm from RIIB for action grants in 2019 2020
- The Nature Conservancy provided facilitation services for first 10 municipal workshops
- o RIIB contracted with TNC for an additional two workshops in 2020
- \$7mm in 2021 Beach, Clean Water, and Green Economy Bond for Action Grants



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Program By the Numbers

Over **400** local leaders have participated in MRP workshops

200 climate resilience projects identified across 13 municipalities

Estimated **\$48mm** in project costs across 2019 municipalities

Catalyst for **\$8mm** in outside funding and financing for MRP projects since 2019

\$2mm in RIIB Action Grants allocated or scheduled

\$7mm included in 2021 Green Bond for voter approval
