Ocean State Climate Adaptation & Resilience (OSCAR) Fund

Applications due June 21st, 2024

- Eligible Projects:
 - Projects that reduce the vulnerability of low-lying infrastructure on public land through measures that include removal and relocation of infrastructure
 - Restoration of river and stream floodplains, including regrading of banks
 - Revegetation
 - Acquisition of that area of land necessary to maintain and preserve public access
 - Redesigning, resizing, and replacing culverts and bridge spans at existing wetland crossings
 - Additional adaptation and resilience projects deemed to be eligible under R.I. Gen. Laws § 46-23.3-5
- <u>Project Types:</u> Planning, Design, Construction, among other activity types
- Entities who own or control public land are eligible to apply
- Projects must deliver feasible and technically sound climate adaptation solutions with habitat restoration and public access co-benefits
- Projects with Environmental Justice and Community Engagement benefits prioritized


Capacity Building & Partnerships


4. Transparency & Information Sharing
